



NOTICE OF NOMINATIONS

OF THE

UAN UNITED AMERICAN NURSES, AFL-CIO

Nominations for the offices of UAN President, Vice-President, two (2) Directors, three (3) Nominations Committee members, three (3) Hearing Panel members, and one (1) Hearing Panel Alternate will take place as described below. With the exception of the term of office for one (1) Nominations Committee position and one (1) Hearing Panel position (both of which shall be for one (1) year), all terms of office shall run for two (2) years, commencing March 16, 2006, at the conclusion of the 2006 National Labor Assembly.*

NOMINATIONS

Nomination forms may be submitted in writing by mail, e-mail or fax to the UAN Secretary-Treasurer at the address listed below. Nomination forms are available from the UAN Governance Department, E&GW Chairpersons, or Affiliate Program Directors. Nominations may be submitted at any time prior to the National Labor Assembly. Nominations also may be made by delegates on March 15, 2006, at the designated time at the National Labor Assembly.

To be included in the 2006 Candidate Profile Book, the UAN Secretary-Treasurer must receive a candidate's nomination form no later than January 16, 2006.

Before the close of nominations at the National Labor Assembly, all nominated candidates must submit a written consent to serve form, contained in the enclosed nominations forms, to the Nominations Committee, c/o the UAN Secretary-Treasurer, at the address shown below.

No member may accept nomination for or serve in more than one office or position.

ELIGIBILITY TO NOMINATE

In order to nominate or self-nominate, a member must be in good standing in the UAN in accordance with Article II.A.4 of the UAN Constitution (posted on www.UANNurse.org).

ELIGIBILITY TO RUN FOR OFFICE

To be eligible to run for office, a member must be in continuous good standing in the UAN as defined in Article II.A.4 of the UAN Constitution for a period of at least six (6) months immediately preceding nomination.

* The transitional provisions in the first UAN Constitution provided that the candidate receiving the least number of votes among the top three vote getters shall be elected for a one-year term. The two candidates receiving the highest number of votes among the top three vote getters shall be elected for two-year terms. In the event there is no one candidate who receives the least number of votes among the top three candidates, the one-year (1) term shall be determined by lot.
